

Medicare Reporting Update Fact Sheet

- 25,000 RRE registrations for Non Group Health Plans to date
- RRE Registration to remain open indefinitely
- CMS experiencing bugs and extended delays in processing live Query Files
- Testing for ALL RRE IDs scheduled to begin January 2010
- Live data exchange scheduled to begin April 2010
- Updated User Guide (3.0) scheduled to be published by CMS before the end of 2009 to include:
 - Revised definition of RRE
 - Guidance for reporting Mass Tort Claims (multi-party litigation)
 - Guidelines for foreign RRE's
 - We anticipate there will be some technical changes as well
- New procedures released for resolution of Conditional Payments from CMS
- RREs generally are not required to report liability insurance (including self-insurance) or no-fault insurance settlements, judgments, awards or other payments where the date of incident (DOI) **as defined by CMS** was prior to December 5, 1980.
